



Rolling Rivers Stream Trailer

- ◆ The Kootenai River Network Stream Trailer is a classroom on wheels for illustrating stream dynamics and watershed principles.
- ◆ Concepts and issues can be customized to meet the needs of local watersheds and watershed groups.

The Stream Trailer comes loaded with sand and a self-contained tank for pumping and re-circulating water.

We demonstrate erosion by carving different kinds of stream channels in the sand to see the effects of different flow conditions and the effects of different kinds of land use.

CONCEPTS

River Energy — — — — Track water speed in different stream conditions.

Riparian Areas — — — Learn the effect of stream bank vegetation.

Culverts — — — — — Look at the effect of culverts on stream dynamics.

Storm Sewers — — — See the impact of storm runoff.

Bank stability — — — — Learn the effect of stream bank vegetation.

Wetland Traps — — — See how wetlands trap fine sediment from runoff.

Stream Restoration — Learn how to bring back normal stream functioning.
